Women cops rescue minor girl

ITANAGAR, Oct 03: In a bizarre incident, a father sold his seven-year-old daughter at Damin Circle in remote Kurung Kumey district last month.

Lokam Yaki, the child from Tarla Village was allegedly sold by her own father Lokam Tagi on September 3 last to one Gangte Tado of Leel Village under Sangram Circle of the district for a paltry amount of thirty thousand.

Tado along with his brother Gangte Taniang later sold the minor to Gangte Togbe, differently abled person for an amount of 1.5 lakh, Itanagar Women Police Station OC C N Bui told The Arunachal Pioneer on Saturday.

As there was no



whereabouts of the lost child for almost a month, on September 27 last Yaki's (victim) paternal uncle Lokam Nai finally got a clue on the girl who was confined at the residence of one Hillang Takio at Koloriang.

After many efforts and

requests when Takio and Gangte brothers were not willing to hand over the girl to her uncle, Nai eventually filed a FIR at Itanagar Women Police Station on October 2 last.

After receipt of the complaint, SI N Angu on the same day along with her team under the supervision of OC Bui successful arrested the trio excluding Takio, within an hour from Naharlagun.

The girl is now safe with her uncle Nai after a horrible ordeal, the OC added.

Meanwhile, The Lokam Welfare Society (LWS) has congratulated the police for taking prompt action and saving the innocent child from the clutches of human traffickers and arresting the rest of the absconders.
